Michael Andretti Inducted Into Motorsports Hall of Fame of America

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind. (Aug. 13, 2008) -- Andretti Green Racing co-owner and racing legend Michael Andretti has been inducted into the Motorsports Hall of Fame of America. Andretti was enshrined as part of the Hall's 20th annual Induction Ceremony on August 13 at the Fillmore Detroit.

In addition to Andretti, the class of 2008 includes NASCAR great Buddy Baker, drag racing king John Force, sports car champion Richie Ginther, motorcycle hero Wayne Rainey, aerobatic pilot Betty Skelton, and one of America's most versatile competitors, Paul Goldsmith.

Legendary Indy car team owner Carl Haas was also recognized as the ninth recipient of the Bob Russo Heritage Award for his significant contribution to American motorsports.

The current list of 167 men and women that grace the Hall of Fame roster includes Mario Andretti, A.J. Foyt, Lee and Richard Petty, Al and Bobby Unser, Chris Economaki, Don Garlits, Shirley Muldowney, Bill France Jr., and Dale Earnhardt, among the historic list of others.
